


3D Crochet Table Topper


Row 2 – ch 3, (dc in next dc, ch 1) 15 times, sl st into 2nd ch of beg. ch of row. (16 dc, 16 ch 1 spaces)

• Row 3 – sl st into next ch 1 sp ch 2, 2 dc in same sp, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp) 15 times. sl st in 2nd ch of beg. ch of row (48 dc)

Row 4 - ch 2, 1 dc in each on next 3 dc,2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc (ch 1, 1 dc in each of next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc) 7 times, ch 1, sl st in 2nd ch of beg. ch of row. (8 groups of 7 dc, 8 ch 1 sp)

Row 5 – ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in each on next 5 dc, (ch 1, 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in each of next 5 dc,) 7 times, ch 1, sl st in 2nd ch of beg. ch or row (8 groups of 8 dc, 8 ch 1 sp)

• Row 6 – ch 2, 1 dc in each on next 5 dc,2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc (ch 1, 1 dc in



- Row 7 ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in each on next 7 dc, (ch 1, 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in each of next 7 dc,) 7 times, ch 1, sl st in 2nd ch of beg. ch of row (8 groups of 10 dc, 8 ch 1 sp)
- Row 8 ch 2, 1 dc in each on next 7 dc,2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc (ch 1, 1 dc in each of next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc) 7 times, ch 1, sl st in 2nd ch at beg. ch of row (8 groups of 11 dc, 8 ch 1 sp)
- Row 9 ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in each on next 9 dc, (ch 2, 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in each of next 9 dc,) 7 times, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch of beg. ch of row (8 groups of 12 dc, 8 ch 1 sp)
- Row 10 sc in same sp, 1 sc in each of next 11 sc, (ch 2, 3 dc in ch 2 sp, ch 2, 1 sc in each of next 12 dc) 7 times, ch 2, 3 dc in ch 2 sp, ch 2, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 11 sl st in next sc, sc in same stitch, 1 sc in each of next 9 sc, (ch3, 3 dc in next ch 2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 2 sp, ch 3, sk next sc, 1 sc in next 10 sc) 7 times, ch3, 3 dc in next ch 2 sp, ch 3, sl st in first sc of row.




- Row 12 sl st in next sc, sc in same stitch, 1 sc in each of next 7 sc, (ch 4, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, 1 sc in next 8 sc) 7 times, ch 4, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 4, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 13 sl st in next sc, sc in same stitch, 1 sc in each of next 5 sc, [ch 5, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp, ch 5, sk next sc, 1 sc in next 6 sc] 7 times, ch 5, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp, ch 5, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 14 sl st in next 4 sc, sl st into next 4 chs, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch 5 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 3,[3 dc in next ch 5 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 3] 7 times, sl st in 2nd ch of row.
- Row 15 sc in same st as sl st, (sc in each dc and ch 1 sp across, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 2) 8 times, sl st in first sc of row. (19 sc in each group)
- Row 16 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 16 sc, (ch 3, 3 dc in ch 2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 2 sp, ch 3, sk next sc, sc in next 17 sc) 7 times, ch 3, 3 dc in ch 2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 2 sp, ch 3, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 17 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 14 sc, (ch 4, 3 dc in ch 3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next 15 sc) 7 times, ch 4, 3 dc in ch 3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 4, sl st in first sc of row.



•	Row 18 - sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 12 sc, [ch 5, 3 dc in ch 4 sp, ch 1, (3
	dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) twice, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp, ch 5, sk next sc, sc in next 13 sc] 7
	times, ch 5, 3 dc in ch 4 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) twice, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp,
	ch 5, sl st in first sc of row.

- Row 19 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 10 sc, [ch 6, 3 dc in ch 5 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 11 sc]
 7 times, ch 6, 3 dc in ch 5 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 6, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 20 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 8 sc, [ch 7, 3 dc in ch 6 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch 6 sp, ch 7, sk next sc, sc in next 9 sc] 7 times, ch 7, 3 dc in ch 6 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch 6 sp, ch 7, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 21 sl st in next 8 sc, sl st into next 6 chs, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch 7 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 5 times, 3 dc in next ch 7 sp, [ch 5, 3 dc in next ch 7 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1), 5 times, 3 dc in ch 7] 7 times, ch 5, sl st 2nd ch of row.
- Row 22 sc in same st as sl st, (sc in each dc and ch 1 sp across, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 3) 8 times, sl st in first sc of row. (27 sc in each group)
- Row 23 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 24 sc, (ch 4, 3 dc in ch 3 sp, ch 1, 3



- Row 24 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 22 sc, (ch 5, 3 dc in ch 4 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 3 sp, ch 5, sk next sc, sc in next 23 sc) 7 times, ch 5, 3 dc in ch 4 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch 4 sp, ch 5, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 25 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 20 sc, [ch 6, 3 dc in ch 5 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) twice, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 21 sc] 7 times, ch 6, 3 dc in ch 5 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) twice, 3 dc in next ch 5 sp, ch 6, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 26 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 18 sc, [ch 7, 3 dc in ch 6 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch 6 sp, ch 7, sk next sc, sc in next 19 sc] 7 times, ch 7, 3 dc in ch 6 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch 6 sp, ch 7, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 27 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 16 sc, [ch 8, 3 dc in ch 7 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch 7 sp, ch 8, sk next sc, sc in next 17 sc] 7 times, ch 8, 3 dc in ch 7 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch 7 sp, ch 8, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 28 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 14 sc, [ch 9, 3 dc in ch 8 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 5 times, 3 dc in next ch 8 sp, ch 9, sk next sc, sc in next 15 sc]
 7 times, ch 9, 3 dc in ch 8 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 5 times, 3 dc in next ch 8



- Row 29 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 12 sc, [ch 10, 3 dc in ch 9 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 6 times, 3 dc in next ch 9 sp, ch 10, sk next sc, sc in next 13 sc] 7 times, ch 10, 3 dc in ch 9 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 6 times, 3 dc in next ch 9 sp, ch 10, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 30 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 10 sc, [ch 11, 3 dc in ch 10 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 7 times, 3 dc in next ch 10 sp, ch 11, sk next sc, sc in next 11 sc] 7 times, ch 11, 3 dc in ch 10 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch 1 sp, ch 1) 7 times, 3 dc in next ch 10 sp, ch 11, sl st in first sc of row.
- Row 31 sl st in next sc, sc in same st, sc in next 8 sc, [ch 12, (sk next dc, sl st in next dc, in next ch1 sp -1 hdc 1 dc 1 tr 1 dc 1 hdc) 8 times, sk next dc, sl st in next dc, ch 12, sk next sc, sc in next 9 sc] 7 times, ch 12, (sk next dc, sl st in next dc, in next ch1 sp -1 hdc 1 dc 1 tr 1 dc 1 hdc) 8 times, sk next dc, sl st in next dc, ch 12, sl st in first sc of row, finish off, weave in ends.
