- 3. Chain 3 to start the next round.
- 4. In the first treble crochet of the previous row, make 3 single crochets.
- 5. In the second treble crochet of the previous row, make 3 single crochets.
- 6. Continue by making 1 single crochet in each of the next four stitches.
- 7. In the treble crochet at the bottom/point of the heart, work 1 single crochet, 1 double crochet, and 1 single crochet to shape the bottom of the heart.
- 8. Proceed by making 1 single crochet in each of the next four stitches.
- 9. Make 3 single crochets in the next treble crochet of the previous row.
- 10. Finally, make 3 single crochets in the last treble crochet of the previous row.
- 11. Chain 3 to complete the round. Then, make 1 slip stitch in the middle of the heart.
- 12. Fasten off your work, and your crochet heart is complete!


Valentine's Day Decor: Adorn your home with crochet hearts as bunting, table centerpieces, or wall hangings for a romantic atmosphere.
