

# **Easy Baby Shoes – Free Crochet Patterns**



Easy Baby Shoes patterns: Crochet is an amazing art that we can make beautiful craft pieces,. Today we are going to explore all the cuteness of this beautiful model of baby shoes. In addition to being very easy to make. This pattern will be a great option for your baby, or even as a gift.

Whether you're a beginner or a more advanced crocheter, this pattern will be a great piece to add to your project list. you will easily make this shoe pattern with just a few basic crochet techniques you already know. With wonderful options of colors, shapes and sizes. You will be able to explore beautiful easy patterns of Baby Shoes that you can easily make at home.

So if you are a beginner crochet artist and want to increase your crochet knowledge level. You will have a lot of fun. as this pattern only requires a few basic stitches to be made. The materials needed to make these beautiful shoes are: a crochet hook, a tapestry needle and the yarn you want to use. But we recommend that you use softer yarn, as this is a pattern for babies. So you can use acrylic or cotton threads.



## **Materials:**

Lightweight Baby Yarn

Crochet Hook size G (Please disregard the Hook Size F shown in the pictures; they were taken during experimentation. Hook Size G yields better results for this pattern.)
Ribbon flowers or Ribbon bows.

### The Tutorial:

#### Shoe Sole:

Round 1: Chain 10, single crochet (sc) in the 2nd chain from the hook, 1 sc in the next 7 chains, then make 5 sc in the last chain. Working back along the opposite side of the chain, make 1 sc in the next 7 chains, and 2 sc in the last chain. Slip stitch (sl st) to the first sc. (Total of 22 stitches)



Round 2: Chain 2, half double crochet (hdc) in the same stitch, 1 hdc in the next 7 stitches, 2

hdc in the next 5 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 7 stitches, and 2 hdc in the last 2 stitches. Slip stitch to the beginning chain-2. (Total of 30 stitches)



Round 3: Chain 2, hdc in the same stitch, 1 hdc in the next 12 stitches, 2 hdc in the next 3 stitches, 1 hdc in the next 12 stitches, and 2 hdc in the last 2 stitches. Slip stitch to the beginning chain-2. (Total of 36 stitches) Do not cut the yarn. Continue to work on the sides and toe of the shoe.





### Shoe Sides and Toe:

From this point on, you will work in continuous rounds. There's no need to slip stitch at the end of each round; simply make your next stitch directly on top of the stitch from the previous round. Using a stitch marker or safety pin can be helpful to mark the beginning of each round.





Round 4: Chain 2, work 1 hdc in each stitch all around. (Total of 36 stitches)

Round 5: Work 1 hdc in each stitch all around. (Total of 36 stitches)





Round 6: Work 1 hdc in the next 12 stitches, then work a decrease over 2 stitches (dc2tog) a total of 6 times, and finally work 1 hdc in the last 12 stitches. (Total of 30 stitches)

Round 7: Work 1 single crochet (sc) in the next 12 stitches, then work dc2tog 4 times, and finish with 1 sc in the last 11 stitches. (Total of 28 stitches) Tie off and weave in the loose ends.



Add Decorations to the Baby Shoes!

I opted for the pre-made bows and flowers available here. These little embellishments are charming, diminutive, and can be effortlessly affixed. However, you can also choose to hand-cut some ribbon and fasten it with a knot! Either approach will result in an adorably cute outcome!
