

How to Crochet Piggy Baby Booties



Crocheting baby booties is not only a fun and creative craft but also a delightful way to keep those tiny toes warm and stylish. If you're looking to make a charming and adorable pair of baby booties, why not try your hand at crocheting piggy-themed booties?

In this step-by-step guide, we'll walk you through the process of creating cute and cozy piggy baby booties that will make a perfect gift for any baby shower or a wonderful addition to your own little one's wardrobe.



Materials You'll Need

Before you start crocheting, gather the following materials:

Worsted weight yarn in pink, white, and black. Crochet hook size G/4.0mm. Yarn needle. Scissors. Stitch markers (optional). Two small black buttons for the eyes (safety eyes or sew-on buttons).

Tutorial:

Step 1: Create the Sole

Start by making a foundation chain of 10 stitches in pink yarn. This will be the sole of the bootie.

Single crochet (SC) into the second chain from the hook and into each remaining chain across. You should have a total of 9 SC stitches.

Chain 1, turn your work, and continue to single crochet in each stitch across for 6 rows. This will create the sole of the bootie.

Step 2: Crochet the Upper Part

After finishing the sole, continue working in rounds without turning.

Single crochet 6 stitches evenly along one side of the sole, then 6 stitches along the other side, and join with a slip stitch to the first SC to form a round. You should have 12 stitches in this round.

Single crochet in each of the next 4 rounds. This will form the upper part of the bootie.

Step 3: Shape the Piggy's Nose

In the next round, single crochet 6 stitches, then crochet 2 SC into the next stitch. Repeat this pattern one more time (18 stitches in total).

Single crochet in each of the next 2 rounds (18 stitches per round).

In the following round, single crochet 6 stitches, then single crochet 2 stitches together. Repeat this pattern one more time (12 stitches in total).

Single crochet in each of the next 2 rounds (12 stitches per round).



Step 4: Finish the Bootie

Cut a long tail of pink yarn, thread it through your yarn needle, and weave it through the front loops of the remaining 10 stitches. Pull tight to close the snout.

Use black yarn to embroider a small, smiling mouth on the snout.

Sew two small black buttons (or use safety eyes) above the snout to create the eyes.

Step 5: Add Piggy's Ears

For each ear, make a small pink circle by crocheting 6 SC into a magic ring. Slip stitch to the first SC to close the circle and fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Attach the ears to the sides of the bootie, positioning them slightly above the snout.

Step 6: Complete the Bootie

Weave in any loose ends with a yarn needle.

Repeat all the steps to create the second bootie.
